Albioma wins 17 MWp in solar projects in Overseas France

Albioma announced today that it has won an aggregate capacity of 17 MWp in the July 2019 governmental call for tenders for "ground-array and rooftop photovoltaic projects in non-interconnected areas in Corsica and the French overseas territories".

This capacity is distributed across 27 projects (8 with storage and 19 without storage) located in the overseas regions where Albioma is already present: Reunion Island, Mayotte, French Guiana and Guadeloupe.

Construction of these projects is planned for 2021.

Frédéric Moyne, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Albioma, declared: *"With 17 MWp won out of the 91 MWp allocated to our regions (excluding Corsica), we are demonstrating the expertise of our teams and the competitiveness of our projects. In the current very specific context of the Covid-19 health crisis, I would like to pay tribute to the commitment of all Group employees, who ensure the continuity of the electricity production service on a daily basis. To date, all our thermal and solar power plants are operational, with the exception of ALM-3 (in Guadeloupe) which is shut down for biomass conversion work. This also makes it possible to ensure the supply of energy for the smooth running of the sugar harvests in the West Indies. "*

Next on the agenda: revenue for the first quarter of 2020 on 27 April 2020 (after trading).
