Albioma in the lead for the tender on solar energy in non-interconnected zones

Further to the publication by the French Ministry of Ecological Transition of the results of the sixth period of the call for tenders relating to the construction and operation of solar electricity production facilities in non-interconnected areas (ZNI), Albioma announces that it has been awarded an aggregate power of 12.16 MWp.

This puts Albioma at the top of the podium in terms of capacity won in the tender, and confirms its position as the leader in solar power in the French overseas territories.

This power is spread across 19 projects, both ground-mounted and rooftop, located in the French overseas territories where Albioma is already present: Reunion Island, Martinique, French Guiana and Guadeloupe.

Construction of these projects is scheduled to begin in 2024.

Albioma is an independent renewable energy producer, supporting the energy transition with renewable energies (biomass, solar and geothermal).

The Group operates in Overseas France, Metropolitan France, Mauritius, Brazil, Turkey and Canada.
